Announcement Concerning Honeywell Product Codes

Dear Customer,

Last December, Honeywell acquired a part of the Seelze, Germany-based laboratory research chemicals business from Sigma-Aldrich. Many of the acquired products had suffixes including -H, -R, -F, -A, -D, and VOLPAC attached to the product number. These suffixes were used for various internal administrative purposes and, in the case of VOLPAC, to indicate specialised packaging.

This may affect the following brands: Fluka®, Hydranal® and Chromasolv®

Change to Product Numbers

From November 15, Honeywell is removing suffixes (-H, -R, -F, -A, -D, and VOLPAC) from their product codes. See the table below for some examples of old and new product numbers.

Old Product Number	New Product Number
01010-30KG-R	01010-30KG
04272-25KG-H	04272-25KG
02884-2.5L-F	02884-2.5L
442410-100G-A	442410-100G
34256-10L-VOLPAC	34256-10L-VP
34851-100ML-D	34851-100ML

This means that when you look for Honeywell products you do not need to include these suffixes to find the acquired products.
